- 4. Coordinate activities that are organized by SHRL.








Electrical Safety

The electrical standard in Hong Kong is 220V/50Hz AC. Most electric outlets accommodate three-pin square plugs (British Standard BS1363). Residents should only buy and use 3-pin plugs which comply with the Hong Kong safety requirements.

To prevent circuit overload and fire, no more than one adaptor or one extension unit should be inserted into a socket outlet. No adaptor should be inserted into any extension unit or vice versa. Never use equipment with frayed cords, damaged insulation or broken plugs.
